Cookies of this type are necessary for certain areas of the site to function properly. Cookies in this category include both persistent cookies and session cookies. In the absence of such cookies, the site or some portions of it may not work properly. Therefore, they are always used, regardless of user preferences. The cookies in this category are always sent from our domain.

Analytical Cookie

Cookies of this type are used to collect information about the use of the site. The data controller can use this information for statistical analysis, to improve the site and simplify its use, as well as to monitor its proper functioning. This type of cookie collects anonymous information about the activity of the users in the site and how they arrived at the site and the pages visited. Cookies in this category are sent from the site itself or from third-party domains.
